
Spotlight on Zambia, Zimbabwe, Malawi and Ethiopia

- 01 Today is World AIDS Day. Let us be mindful of all the people suffering with HIV and AIDS. Let us pray for healing and the distribution of healthcare, particularly for the children who have been infected or orphaned by this disease.
- **02** Let us pray for the growth of all the new believers who gave their hearts to Christ during the 60th Anniversary Mission that took place in Lusaka, Zambia, earlier this year.
- **03** Pray that new believers are growing spiritually and emotionally with the help of our church partners.
- **04** Pray for the AESAR Team Leader, Lutangu Lubasi, that God will give him the wisdom and strength to lead the Southern Region team forward in a godly way.
- **05** Let us pray for the AE Teams to build effective partnerships with the churches and city officials, in order to spread the Gospel more easily and more effectively to even more people, as the missions for 2023 are being planned.
- **06** Pray for our Missions Director, Emmanuel Kwizera, as he prepares for the 2023 missions.
- O7 Pray that those Christians trained in evangelism and discipleship in Lusaka will continue to proclaim the name of Jesus at every opportunity.
- **08** Thank the Lord for making the Lusaka 60th Anniversary Mission possible this year.
- **09** Thank God for sending 1,277 missioners to serve Lusaka, and for the 258 churches that participated.
- 10 Today is Human Rights Day. We are all one in God, created in His image. Let us pray for people's right to food and water, their right to live in peace, their right to good healthcare and their right to life.
- **11** Pray for Brian Mugwidi, AE Zimbabwe Team Leader, who started this year, and for resources to finish the Zimbabwe office renovations (after the office burned down at the end of 2020).
- 12 Let us pray that Zimbabwe will be able to start the Women Empowerment Project again in 2023, where 10 vulnerable women are expected to benefit from a tailoring project.
- 13 Pray that Zimbabwe will be able to put the Foxfires Team back together. This has always been a flagship program of Zimbabwe. Churches are already requesting the Foxfires to help plant churches in new residential areas. Foxfires will provide the visibility that the AE Team needs and help to rebuild the work in the shortest possible time.
- 14 Please pray that Zimbabwe will have enough resources by May 2023 for a planned regional mission in Mutare, and that AE will be able to share their vision with the local leadership before the end of 2022.

- **15** AE Zimbabwe has a burning desire to evangelise and relaunch all activities. Pray that God will hear our prayers and get the Team out in the field again soon.
- **16** Keep Cornelius Huwa, the AE Malawi Director, in your prayers as he and his team are in full planning mode for the 2023 program.
- **17** Praise God for the multitudes of people reached by the Foxfire ministry this year.
- **18** Pray that God will send willing and ready-to-serve young people for the new Foxfire intake for 2023.
- **19** AE Ethiopia kicks off its citywide mission in Adama today. The mission will take place over six days. Pray for the missioners as they go into the streets to proclaim the Gospel.
- **20** Pray that the missioners in Adama will be clear in presenting Christ crucified.
- **21** Pray that all missioners in Adama will have confidence that the Word of God will transform the lives of many people.
- 22 Adama is a city plagued by many social problems. Pray that the local Churches will have the wisdom to address these issues in the name of Jesus.
- **23** Pray that God will lead the missioners to people whose hearts are open to receiving the Good News of Jesus.
- **24** Pray that all the new believers in Adama will be welcomed and integrated into local churches.
- **25** Today is the final day of the Adama Mission. Pray that the Word of God will spread through the city like a wildfire.
- 26 The second round of the sewing training project for 15 vulnerable women is in good progress in Ethiopia. Let us thank God for the change that He is bringing in the lives of these women.
- 27 The first-round sewing graduates from Ethiopia are in the process of starting their own businesses in their Community Transformation Groups. Pray that our Father will guide them and bless them as they use their new skills to transform their communities.
- 28 Let us pray that the women who have been part of the Vocational Skills in Tailoring for Vulnerable Women project in Malawi will be empowered to undertake start-up initiatives in the community through their tailoring businesses.
- 29 Pray with us that the women in the Malawi tailoring project will be completely spiritually transformed, filled with the Holy Spirit.
- **30** Pray that the women in the Malawi tailoring project will be empowered through Community Transformation Groups.
- **31** Pray that AE Malawi would be blessed with the resources to be able to train even more women in 2023.
