## Spotlight on West Africa Missions

- 01 Pray for preparations for the mission to Atakpame, Togo, from February 17 to 26.
- 02 Pray for safe travel for AE Ghana Team Leader Ben Sachie and his Team, who will travel 200 miles from Accra, Ghana, to Atakpame.
- 03 Pray for unity among the Christians, pastors and church leaders in Atakpame, that they would share a common passion for the Gospel and for evangelism and discipleship.
- 04 Pray for open hearts among people in Atakpame who will hear the Gospel, that they will respond in repentance and faith.
- 05 Pray for the training of counselors in Atakpame, that they will be well equipped to help new believers start well in their new faith.
- 06 Pray for continued good health for Ben Sachie and his Team and all the mission workers in Togo, that they will remain free of COVID and other illnesses.
- 07 Pray for AEUSA Executive Director Jamie Morrison as he leaves today for three weeks in Rwanda, South Sudan, Kenya and Tanzania, for safe travel, divine connections, fruitful meetings with AE colleagues and protection and blessing for his wife and children back home.
- 08 Pray for guidance and wisdom for AE in exploring new ministry outreach in West Africa in the coming years, especially in Nigeria, Burkina Faso, Liberia, Sierra Leone, Ivory Coast and Guinea.
- 09 Pray for Nii Amoo Darku, the Ghana Board Chair, and the Ghana Board as they lead the AE Ghana operation.
- 10 Pray for Lynn Nwagbara, AE Europe Executive Director, joining in on the Atakpame Mission, for guidance and direction.
- 11 Pray for families providing accommodation for visiting missionaries to Atakpame, that they will be able to provide good hospitality.
- 12 Pray for the churches in Atakpame as they gather for Sunday worship today, that parishioners will feel God's presence and be drawn into adoration of Him.
- 13 Pray for wisdom and guidance for AE's International Board members as they meet in Kigali, Rwanda, today and tomorrow, led by Chairman Antoine Rutayisire.
- 14 Pray for local funding from the Atakpame community to come through to help support the mission.
- 15 Pray for preparations for the mission to the University of Ghana in Accra, set for March 19-26.
- 16 Pray for Jamie Morrison, AE Australia Executive Director Simba Musvamhiri and Social Action Director Janet Mwendwa as they visit Juba, South Sudan, to visit with South Sudan Team Leader Alex Billal and his colleagues and Board until February 19.
- 17 Pray for a fruitful launch of the Atakpame Mission today, that all transportation and logistical matters will work smoothly and that the Gospel will begin to be clearly proclaimed.
- 18 Pray for Christians who already minister on the University of Ghana campus, that they will unite together and work seamlessly with the AE Ghana Team in proclaiming the Gospel next month.
- 19 Pray again for the churches in Atakpame as they gather today, that they would be excited and passionate about the mission and that they would be motivated to share the Gospel with family, friends and co-workers.
- 20 Pray for wisdom, guidance and direction for Jamie Morrison, Simba Musvamhiri, AE International Team Leader Stephen Mbogo and International Missions Director Emmanuel Kwizera as they meet in Nairobi, Kenya, today through February 22 for planning and team-building.
- 21 Pray that churches near the University of Ghana would develop an increased heart for the university students, participate in the mission and carry out further ministry into the future.
- 22 Pray that the minds of the university students in Accra would be prepared to hear and understand the Gospel and that they would begin to have a sense for how desperately they need Jesus as their Lord and Savior.
- 23 Pray for the professors, faculty and staff at the University of Ghana, that those who are already Christians would be courageous in their faith and that those who don't know Jesus will come to him in faith.
- 24 Pray for revival to come to the University of Ghana as new believers share their faith with friends.
- 25 Pray for the conclusion of the University of Ghana Mission tomorrow, that all who have put their lives in Christ's hands will continue to grow in their faith and become fruitful disciples.
- 26 Pray for Jamie Morrison as he flies to Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, to meet with AE Tanzania Team Leader Emmanuel Mbaaga and Board Chair Joseph Mayala.
