Evangelizing the Cities of Africa through Word and Deed in Partnership with the Church

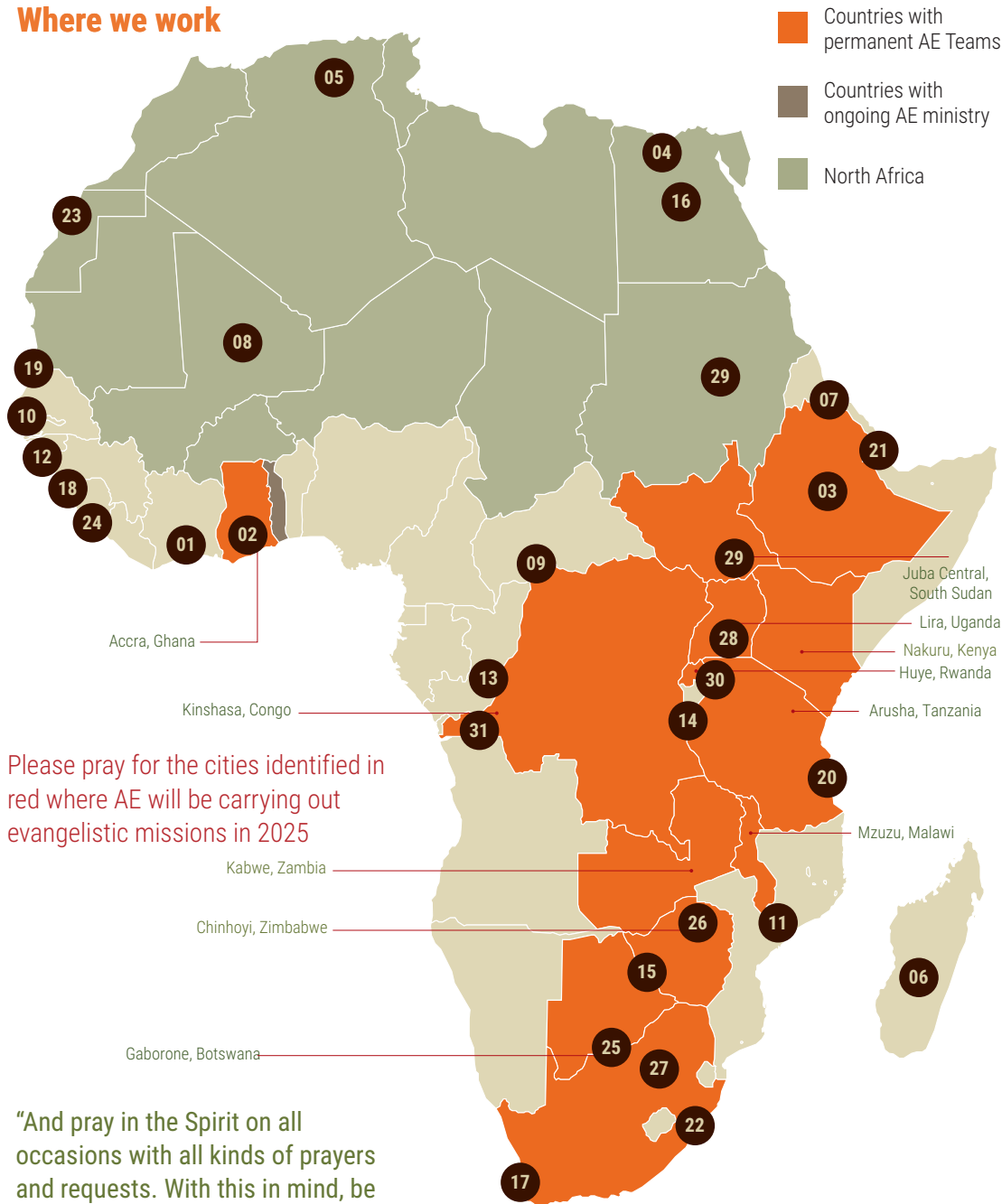
NOVEMBER 2025

- 01** Pray for the Juba Central Mission in South Sudan (November 21-30, 2025) - that hearts would be open to the Gospel and that local churches would be unified in their witness.
- 02** Pray for God's protection and journey mercies for all team members participating in the Juba Mission.
- 03** Pray for the Arusha Mission in Tanzania (November 27 - December 7, 2025) - for breakthrough in reaching this strategic city with the Gospel and for the church in Tanzania to be committed to spread the Gospel.
- 04** Pray for protection and traveling safety for all participating in the Arusha Mission in Tanzania.
- 05** Praise God for calling African Enterprise to conduct 12 major citywide Gospel campaigns across Africa in 2026, reaching an estimated 1.6 million people.
- 06** Pray for final preparations for the early 2026 city missions in South Africa (Ulundi - March), DRC (Kenge - June), Kenya (Embu - June/ July), and Rwanda (Rusizi - July).
- 07** Pray for wisdom in planning the fall 2026 missions in Zimbabwe (Masvingo), Zambia (Kitwe), Tanzania (Mbeya), Ghana (Kumasi), Uganda (Masaka), South Sudan (Yei), and Malawi (Blantyre).
- 08** Pray for the ongoing preparations for the Adama Mission and for spiritual unity among churches and a powerful spiritual impact across the city in Ethiopia.
- 09** Pray for political unrest and violence would come to an end in Congo-DRC, giving way to peace and sustainable development.
- 10** Pray for the continued expansion of the Student Discipleship Program and the Leadership Summit in Ethiopia, and for wisdom and resources to sustain all youth-focused missions.
- 11** Pray for increased resources to expand the social action programs in Kenya and for the increase of partnerships with churches, communities, and stakeholders.
- 12** Pray for sustainable partnerships within churches to advance the Gospel in Malawi, and continue prayer for provision of funds for the Women's Vocational Tailoring Training Program.
- 13** Pray for projects supporting child protection, education, literacy, and youth empowerment in Rwanda, so that lives will be changed both materially and spiritually.
- 14** Pray for courage and adaptability for the Rwanda Team, especially in times of uncertainty and disruption, so that the mission remains strong.
- 15** Pray for financial sustainability for the South Africa Team as they prepare for the Ulundi Mission in March 2026.
- 16** Pray for the youth in South Africa – against bullying and lawlessness, especially in schools, and for Gospel transformation in young lives.
- 17** Pray for peace and stability in South Sudan and for good health and God's protection for the Team and Board members.
- 18** Pray for the general elections in Uganda in January 2026 – for peace, non-violence, and fair democratic processes.
- 19** Praise God for the lives transformed through Social Action activities across Uganda.
- 20** Praise God for successful missions and partnerships in Zambia throughout 2023, 2024, and 2025, and give thanks for the souls reached and saved.
- 21** Pray for more resources to help the Zambia team achieve objectives in both Word and Deed.
- 22** Pray for the launch of African Enterprise's ambitious 5-year Evangelism and Community Empowerment Program (2026-2030), which aims to establish 2,500 Community Transformation Churches across 13 African nations and reach 3.5 million people with the Gospel.
- 23** Pray for the training of 2,400 pastors over the next five years, many of whom have never received formal theological education – that they would be equipped with sound biblical teaching and Kingdom worldview.
- 24** Pray for the distribution of over 1 million Gospel of Luke booklets and 200,000 Bibles across Africa in 2026.
- 25** Pray for the North Africa Reverse Mission Initiative – taking the Gospel back to regions where Christianity once thrived, particularly in Tunisia and other North African countries.
- 26** Pray that the "sleeping giant" of the African Church would awaken to fulfill its calling – faithful in proclaiming the Gospel, transforming lives and communities, and embodying God's Kingdom values.
- 27** Pray for protection and strength for all Mission Teams across Africa as they serve on the front lines of Gospel ministry.
- 28** Pray for all the Team Leaders in Africa as they give leadership to their teams and navigate complex ministry challenges.
- 29** Pray for favor in foundation proposals, new church partnerships, and donor development initiatives in our U.S. and Canadian support offices.
- 30** Pray for God to raise up faithful financial partners in North America who will join us in this historic moment - as Africa's youth population explodes (60% under age 25) and the African Church stands poised to become a major force in global Christianity.
